


<p>Reading</p> <p>We will be reading the following texts this term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 'Island at the Edge of the Night' by Lucy Strange (Fiction) - 'Final Year' by Matt Goodfellow (Fiction) - 'The Song Walker' by Zillah Bethell (Fiction) <p>Please either listen to your child read or ensure they are reading at home regularly.</p>	<p>Writing</p> <p>Using the Jane Considine approach we will be exploring the following forms of writing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Diary Entries based on 'Scott of the Antarctic' - Blog based on 'Pet Peeves' - Poetry based on 'The Malfeasance' <p>In our writing we will be encouraging the children to upskill their vocabulary, use a variety of grammar and refine the skills of editing.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>We will explore the following areas in this term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Shape - Position and Direction - Decimals and Negative Numbers - Converting Units of Measure - Year 6 will be completing some project work based on real life situations. <p>With each unit the children will become confident with the relevant procedures and be able to solve reasoning based problems.</p>
<p>RE</p> <p>We will be exploring Judaism and discussing the question – 'Why is the Torah important to Jewish people?'. We will also explore if faith helps people in Cornwall when life gets hard.</p>	 <p>Oak Class Termly Curriculum Overview Summer 2025</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>We are looking at 'keeping myself safe' and 'Growing and changing' where we will explore how we can look after our bodies and minds as we grow and change as well as keeping ourselves safe in the world and online.</p>
<p>Geography</p> <p>We will be answering the question; 'What are the similarities and differences of the landscapes, climate, and ways of life between the UK and Greece?'. We will explore the physical and human characteristics of each country; the seasonal changes and general climates and how day-to-day life differs between the two.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Our topic is 'Engineering'. We will be investigating all things forces including gravity, air resistance and water resistance. We will also explore levers, pulleys, cogs and gears and the effect these have on mechanisms. We will also explore the scientists Isaac Newton and Galileo Galilei.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>We will be exploring The Ancient Greeks and answering the big questions; 'How did life differ in the Greek city-states? And what impact have the Greeks had on our world today?'. We will explore key events during this time period as well as significant individuals and the impact they had.</p>
<p>Art/DT</p> <p>We will appraise and analyse art through the eyes of the artist Henry Moore, focusing on techniques he has used to create his sculptures. We will analyse, practise these skills then apply them when we create our own sculpture. In DT, we will be using our designing and creating marble runs.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>We will be learning about creating media focussing on vector graphics. We will also practice our programming in relations to designing and creating selection quizzes.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>We will be exploring 'Jazz' music using the tune Three Note Bossa Swing to further our knowledge about the tonality of a piece of music, different musical styles, and the keys they are played in. We will also be learning and practicing songs for our end of year performance.</p>
<p>PE/Outdoor Learning</p> <p>In PE we will having our weekly lessons with Mr Pitman where we will further develop key skills required for games such as tennis. We will also be practicing our athletics and rounders skills this term.</p>
