

Reading We will be reading the following texts this term: - 'Charlotte's Web' by E.B. White (Fiction) - 'Max and the Millions' by Ross Montgomery (Fiction) - In addition, we will also look at a variety of other texts such as informative, persuasion, poetry and scripts. Please listen to your child read regularly to help with fluency and comprehension.	Writing Using the Jane Considine approach we will be exploring the following forms of writing: - Traditional Tale Narrative based on 'The Happy Prince' - Poetry based on 'I Asked the Little Boy Who Couldn't See' - Romance Narrative based on 'Blue Umbrella' - Advert for a Social Media Dessert In our writing we will be encouraging the children to upskill their vocabulary, use a variety of grammar and refine the skills of editing and proofreading.	Maths We will explore the following areas in maths this term: - Place value up to 10,000, looking at composition of numbers, different representations, comparing and ordering and rounding - Addition and subtraction - Multiplication and division - Measurement focussing on Area With each unit the children will become confident with the relevant procedures and skills and be able to solve reasoning based problems.
RE We will begin our RE learning by looking at the Creation Story and what Christians learn from this? Including their views on the world and how it should be treated. We will also be exploring the Islam religion, particularly focussing on how festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim.	 Maple Class - Autumn Term Overview 2026	PSHE We will be investigating the following questions: - 'How do I feel today' (difference between everyday and strong feelings) - 'Who's in my family' (healthy communication and relationships) - 'How do I decide what to do online?' (Online safety)
Geography We will be looking at a local study building our knowledge to help us answer the question: 'Is Cornwall the best county?'. We will explore the landscapes and natural resources, as well as key industries such as farming, fishing and tourism to help up develop our answers.	Science We will be investigating all things related to our amazing bodies. We begin by exploring the bones in our body and why they are important. We then will look at the role of muscles too. We will delve deeper into the workings of our bodies including digestion and the role nutrients play.	History We will be exploring the Stone Age to the Iron Age, answering the question 'When was a better time to live – the Stone Age or the Iron Age?'. We will look into how survival skills developed, settlements beginning and cultural changes between these ages.
Art/DT We will appraise and analyse art through the eyes of the artist L.S. Lowry and explore how artists use line and shape to show people and life in a place. For DT, we will be looking at electrical circuits and create a torch for reading for pleasure.	Computing This unit teaches children that the internet connects lots of computers around the world. They will learn how people use the web to find, share, and create information. Children will also learn how to tell if information online is true and trustworthy.	Music We will be using 'Charanga' to help deepen our understand of music. The unit 'Lean on Me' includes listening, discussing and learning to sing the song 'Lean on Me' by Bill Withers. We will explore the soul/gospel genre using similar songs.
PE/Outdoor Learning In PE we will develop our ball skills focussing on dribbling, throwing, catching, tracking and kicking and then applying these skills to mini games. With our Coach, will also be enhancing our gymnastics skills.
