As Mathematicians we will be learning new knowledge linked to decimals before moving on to looking at money, shape and statistics. As Geographers we will be looking at how the landscapes, climate and way of life in the UK and Greece are similar or different. As Artists we will explore and appraise the work of the artist Henry Moore before working through the unit, exploring sculpture and creating our own clay sculpture piece.
