



#### I am proud to attend my school





### I feel listened to and have a voice in my class and my school community?






#### Do the school values help you to understand how to live together as a school



"Our school values help us understand how to respect other people and help me learn how to love my classmates"


### Does your teacher help you when you find things hard?




# "My teacher talks me through the steps that I am stuck on."

#### What motivates you to learn more?





### I have opportunities to learn about lots of different subjects






#### Given a chance, what is the one change that you would like to see in your school or class?



#### Do you have supportive classmates?




### Do you think that the school provides you with enough sports / musical opportunities?






#### In my class there are clear expectations for behaviour and it's fair

### If I told someone at school I was worried about something they would help me




"If I was worried, I would speak to my friends but the teachers are always there for me too."
